

(vi) Applies to exchange a current license issued under § 4-701(d)(1)(iv) of this subtitle to catch crabs for sale with more than 50 crab pots for a limited license to catch crabs for sale;

(vii) Applies for a new tidal fish license under § 4-701 of this subtitle within 1 year of completion of active military service; or

(viii) Applies to renew a tidal fish license to provide services as a fishing guide under § 4-210 of this title in the Atlantic Ocean, its seaside bays, and their tidal tributaries, including a license on inactive status that was valid on September 1, 1993.

(b) Unless an applicant complies with the provisions of this section, the Department may not issue a new fishing license:

(1) After September 1, 1988, to catch crabs for sale, finfish, oysters, or clams;

(2) After September 1, 1992, to provide services as a fishing guide under § 4-210 of this title in the tidal waters of the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries; or

(3) After September 1, 1993 to provide services as a fishing guide under § 4-210 of this title in the Atlantic Ocean, its seaside bays, and their tributaries.

(c) Before the Department may issue to a person a new tidal fish license, the person must:

(1) Register with the Department on a form provided by the Department at least 2 years before the year of license issuance;

(2) Supply verifiable evidence of any federal license that is issued in the applicant's name by the U.S. Coast Guard to operate a vessel carrying passengers for hire; and

(3) Pay all applicable tidal fish license fees set under § 4-701 of this subtitle at the time of registration.

(d) An applicant is not required to pass a test to obtain a new tidal fish license under this section.

Article - State Government

(a) (1) The Council consists of 28 members appointed by the Governor.

(2) Of the 28 members, 15 of the members shall be individuals with disabilities.

(b) Of the 28 Council members:

(1) 1 shall be a member of the State Senate;

(2) 1 shall be a member of the House of Delegates;
