Section 1

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 1990 in the total principal amount of [\$242,095,402] \$239,502,131. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with Section 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, Section 22 of the Code.

Section 1

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 1991 in the total principal amount of [\$300,034,673] \$299,497,617. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with Section 8-117 through Section 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, Section 22 of the Code.
