

(i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
and

(ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.

(b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1996.

CHAPTER 131

(Senate Bill 339)

AN ACT concerning

Insurance – Unfair Trade Practices – Discrimination Based on Domestic Violence

FOR the purpose of prohibiting insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations from taking certain actions or engaging in certain practices related to underwriting, issuance or renewal of, or payment of claims on life or health insurance policies or health benefit plans based on certain information related to domestic violence; establishing immunity from certain actions for insurers under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; granting certain powers to the Insurance Commissioner; and generally relating to a prohibition against discrimination by certain entities based on domestic violence.
