SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (d) THE GOVERNING BODY OF FREDERICK COUNTY AND OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN FREDERICK COUNTY MAY GRANT, BY LAW, A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION AGAINST THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON REAL PROPERTY THAT IS:
- (1) LEASED TO THE FREDERICK COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OR TO THE FREDERICK COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION; AND
 - (2) USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.
- (E) A taxpayer may apply for a property tax credit under this section on or before October 1 of the taxable year.
- [(e)] (F)(1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A property tax credit granted under this section shall continue until the property is conveyed.
- (2) A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT GRANTED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION SHALL CONTINUE AS LONG AS THE PROPERTY IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THAT SUBSECTION.
