(a) (1) The Board shall place the holder of a general license to practice dentistry or a general license to practice dental hygiene on inactive status and issue an inactive status registration certificate to the licensee, if the licensee:

(i) [Does not meet the requirement of § 4-309(c) of this subtitle to have practiced actively within 3 years before the license expires;

(ii)] Submits to the Board an application for inactive status on the form required by the Board; and

[(iii)] (II) Pays to the Board the inactive status application fee set by the Board.
