CHAPTER 147

(Senate Bill 545)

AN ACT concerning

Assisted Living Programs

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to serve as a point of entry for persons desiring information on assisted living programs; requiring the Department to provide certain information about assisted living to certain persons; specifying the requirements of the Department under this Act as related to assisted living; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations in consultation with certain persons and with the approval of the Office on Aging and the Department of Human Resources; specifying certain provisions of those regulations; altering a certain definition and certain provisions of law related to the definition; altering the name and composition of a certain Board; specifying the responsibilities of the Director of the Office on Aging in regard to assisted living programs; allowing the Department of Human Resources to provide housing under a certain program in certain assisted living program facilities; repealing certain provisions of law related to domiciliary care homes and related institutions; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations by a certain date; making certain technical corrections; providing for a delayed effective date for certain provisions of this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the requirements and responsibilities of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and certain other State agencies in regard to assisted living programs.
