AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages (Class B Beer, Wine and Liquor Beer and Light Wine Licenses)

FOR the purpose of dividing a Class B beer, wine and liquor beer and light wine license in Carroll County into a certain number of licenses, at different annual fees; specifying when the licensees may be open; clarifying language establishing certain restrictions on the hours of operation and the types of sales for a licensee under this Act; making stylistic and technical changes; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Carroll County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
