SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

12-207.

- (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CARROLL COUNTY.
- (B) A LICENSEE MAY NOT SELL, OFFER TO SELL, OR DISPENSE ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FROM WHAT IS COMMONLY TERMED A WALK-UP OR DRIVE-THROUGH WINDOW.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.

## **CHAPTER 162**

(Senate Bill 655)
