- (II) FILE A NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONTEST LIABILITY FOR THE VIOLATION; OR
- (2) IT IS NOTIFIED BY THE DISTRICT COURT THAT A PERSON WHO ELECTED TO CONTEST LIABILITY FOR A VIOLATION OF § 21–1414 OF THIS ARTICLE HAS FAILED TO APPEAR FOR TRIAL.
- (B) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY SUSPEND THE REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE INVOLVED IN A FAILURE TO PAY A TOLL VIOLATION UNDER § 21–1414 OF THIS ARTICLE IF NOTIFIED BY THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY THAT THE VIOLATOR IS A CHRONIC OFFENDER.
- (C) IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO DEFINE CHRONIC OFFENDER AND TO DEVELOP PROCEDURES TO CARRY OUT THE SUSPENSION AND REFUSAL TO REGISTER OR TRANSFER REGISTRATION AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION.
- (D) THE PROCEDURES SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION ARE IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED BY LAW FOR THE FAILURE TO PAY A TOLL OR APPEAR FOR TRIAL FOR A FAILURE TO PAY TOLL VIOLATION UNDER § 21–1414 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.

CHAPTER 220

(House Bill 425)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - The Park Reist Corridor Coalition, Inc.

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$350,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Park Reist Corridor Coalition, Inc. for certain acquisition, development, or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as The Park Reist Corridor Coalition, Inc. Loan of 1996 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i)
