SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 3 of Chapter 362 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994, as amended by Chapter 105 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1995 be repealed.

~~SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND~~ 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

18-203.

The Secretary and all members of the Department of State Police:

- (1) shall treat as confidential any information obtained through an investigation of an applicant for a license under this title; and
- (2) unless required by a court order, may not divulge to a person who is not a [member of the Department of State Police] LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER any information obtained through an investigation of an applicant for a license under this title.

[The] EXCEPT FOR THE COST OF ~~FINGERPRINT CARD~~ THE MARYLAND AND NATIONAL CRIMINAL RECORD CHECKS, THE Secretary shall pay all money collected under this title into the General Fund of the State.

(a) An applicant for a license shall:

- (1) submit to the Secretary an application on the form that the Secretary provides;
- (2) submit the documents required by this section; and
- (3) pay to the Secretary an application fee of \$150 WHICH SHALL INCLUDE THE COST OF ~~A FINGERPRINT CARD~~ THE MARYLAND AND NATIONAL CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK.

(c) Before the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:

- (1) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
- (2) pays to the Secretary a renewal fee of \$100 WHICH SHALL INCLUDE THE COST OF ~~A FINGERPRINT CARD~~ THE MARYLAND AND NATIONAL CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK or the fee provided in subsection (e) of this section, if applicable; and
