- (2) THE BOND SHALL BE USED FOR THE BENEFIT OF ANY PERSON INJURED BY ANY WRONGFUL ACT OF A SECURITY SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN THAT IS WILLFUL OR MALICIOUS.
- (3) THE APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL SUBMIT A COPY OF THE BOND TO THE SECRETARY WITH THE LICENSE APPLICATION.
- (B) (1) THE AMOUNT OF THE BOND REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE AT LEAST \$50,000.
- (2) THE TOTAL LIABILITY OF THE SURETY TO ALL INSURED PERSONS UNDER THE BOND MAY NOT EXCEED THE SUM OF THE BOND.
- (C) (1) IF AN EMPLOYER'S BOND IS CANCELLED, FORFEITED, OR TERMINATED BY THE SURETY, THE SURETY SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE SECRETARY.
- (2) IF A SURETY FAILS TO NOTIFY THE SECRETARY AS REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOND SHALL CONTINUE IN EFFECT UNTIL THE NOTICE IS GIVEN TO THE SECRETARY.
- (D) IN ADDITION TO § 18–504 OF THIS TITLE, A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION MAY ENJOIN THE OPERATION OF ANY EMPLOYER WHO VIOLATES THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
