AN ACT concerning

C. Disposition of funds[; Board of Fire and Rescue Commissioners].

[(1)]The proceeds collected from the county fire and rescue tax shall thereafter be paid by the County Commissioners twice a year, as determined by the Board of Fire and Rescue Commissioners, to all the Fire Departments and rescue squads,
