- (A) IN ADDITION TO POWERS GRANTED UNDER ARTICLE 25A, § 5 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND COUNTY COUNCIL OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY MAY ESTABLISH A REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY THAT HAS THE POWER:

- (2) TO SELL, LEASE, CONVEY, TRANSFER OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF ANY OF THE LAND OR PROPERTY, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT IT HAS BEEN DEVELOPED, REDEVELOPED, ALTERED OR IMPROVED AND IRRESPECTIVE OF THE MANNER OR MEANS IN OR BY WHICH IT MAY HAVE BEEN ACQUIRED, TO ANY PRIVATE, PUBLIC OR QUASI-PUBLIC CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, PERSON OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITY:
