SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 14 - Howard County

- (b) (1) The board shall have [9] 13 voting members appointed by the county executive with the approval of the county council.
- (g) (1) [5] SEVEN members of the board, excluding the ex officio nonvoting member constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting business.
- (2) The affirmative vote of at least [5] SEVEN members is required before the board may take action.

  26.105.
- (a) Within 120 days after the end of the fiscal year, the authority shall send the county executive and the county council an annual financial report [concerning]:
  - (1) CONCERNING:
    - [(1)] (I) The activities of the authority during the fiscal year;
- [(2)] (II) The authority's financial standing at the end of the fiscal year; and
- [(3)](III) Recommendations for the improvement and advancement of the economic welfare of the county; AND
- (2) CONTAINING THE AUDIT REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
