SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 4-106(f)(5) and (6), respectively, of Article - Education of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 4-106(f)(6) and (7), respectively.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

[3-112.1.

(a) The St. Mary's County Board of Education consists of:

- (1) Five voting members; and
- (2) One student member.

(b) The student member shall:

- (1) Be an eleventh or twelfth grade student in the St. Mary's County School System;
- (2) Serve for 1 year;
- (3) Be a nonvoting member; and
