

eligible under criteria established by the lead agency may elect to accept the payment authorized by this subsection in lieu of the payment authorized by subsection (a) of this section.

(2) Such payment shall consist of a fixed payment in an amount to be determined according to criteria established by the lead agency, except that such payment may not be less than \$1,000 nor more than \$20,000 OR THE AMOUNT PROVIDED UNDER THE FEDERAL UNIFORM RELOCATION ASSISTANCE ACT, WHICHEVER IS GREATER.

(3) A person whose sole business at the displacement dwelling is the rental of such property to others shall not qualify for a payment under this subsection.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.

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**CHAPTER 302**

**(House Bill 1089)**

AN ACT concerning

**Anne Arundel County – Recreational Facilities Revenue Authority**

FOR the purpose of authorizing Anne Arundel County to establish a recreational facilities revenue authority as a public corporation and body politic with certain powers, rights, and obligations, subject to certain requirements; authorizing such authority to issue both taxable and tax exempt revenue bonds, notes, and other evidences of indebtedness; and generally relating to the establishment of a recreational facilities revenue authority as a public corporation.
