

TITLE 11. RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY

11-101.

(A) ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, MARYLAND, MAY ESTABLISH BY LOCAL LEGISLATION A RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY.

(B) THE COUNTY IS AUTHORIZED TO ENACT, BY LOCAL LEGISLATION, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION AND PROVISIONS TO SUPPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, IF NOT IN CONFLICT WITH THIS SECTION.

(C) THE COUNTY MAY:

(1) SPECIFY THE ORGANIZATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY;

(2) SPECIFY THE PURPOSES OF THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY;

(3) SPECIFY THE POWERS TO BE EXERCISED BY THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY;

(4) PROVIDE FOR THE EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS, AUTHORITY, RIGHTS, AND OBLIGATIONS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

(5) SPECIFY ANY OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY AS THE COUNTY MAY DETERMINE.

(D) LOCAL LEGISLATION ESTABLISHING THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS:

(1) A PROVISION ESTABLISHING THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY AS A BODY CORPORATE AND POLITIC, WHICH SHALL BE DEEMED AN INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE COUNTY AND A PUBLIC CORPORATION;

(2) A PROVISION ESTABLISHING THE PURPOSES OF THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY;

(3) A PROVISION ESTABLISHING THE POWERS TO BE EXERCISED BY THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY, TO INCLUDE ALL POWERS NECESSARY OR CONVENIENT FOR CARRYING OUT ITS PURPOSES;

(4) A PROVISION ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO MEMBERS AND EMPLOYEES;

(5) A PROVISION ESTABLISHING THAT THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE AUTHORITY MAY PROVIDE BY RESOLUTION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF NEGOTIABLE, TAXABLE AND TAX EXEMPT REVENUE BONDS, REVENUE REFUNDING BONDS, AND OTHER EVIDENCES OF INDEBTEDNESS TO PAY ALL OR PART OF THE COST OR PURCHASE PRICE OF ONE OR MORE PROJECTS OR TO REFUND OUTSTANDING REVENUE BONDS, WHICH REVENUE BONDS MAY BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN ELECTION REFERENDUM OR ANY OTHER PROCEEDINGS OR THE OCCURRENCE OF ANY OTHER CONDITIONS OR EVENTS;
