FOR the purpose of creating a wine tasting alcoholic beverages license in Washington County; providing for the fees and limitations of the license; authorizing the Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Washington County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

8-409.

- (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WASHINGTON COUNTY.
- (B) A SPECIAL WINE TASTING LICENSE (WTL) MAY BE ISSUED ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS A (OFF-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- (B) (C) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$200, IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE OF A CLASS A (OFF-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- (C) (D) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL WINE TASTING LICENSE (WTL) TO PERMIT ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION OF WINE FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING PURPOSES ONLY. CONSIDERATION MAY NOT BE CHARGED OR EXACTED.
- (E) THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL WINE TASTING LICENSE MAY NOT CHARGE FOR THE WINE TASTING OR SAMPLING.
- (D) (<u>F</u>) THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE FOR USE NO MORE THAN 12 DAYS IN A LICENSING YEAR. THE LICENSEE SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD IN WRITING AT LEAST 10 DAYS IN ADVANCE OF ANY SCHEDULED TASTING DATE.
- (E) (G) SERVINGS ARE LIMITED TO NO MORE THAN 2 OUNCES OF ANY ONE WINE TO ANY ONE CUSTOMER.
- (F) (H) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
