SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

9-1015.

- (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated[:].
- (2) "CERTIFIED OR ABRIDGED COPY" MEANS A COPY OF A RESTRICTED VITAL RECORD THAT CONTAINS ONLY THE PERSONAL INFORMATION THAT APPEARS ON THE CERTIFICATE OF BIRTH AND DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY CONFIDENTIAL MEDICAL INFORMATION APPEARING ON THE CERTIFICATE.
- [(1)](3) "Department" means the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.
- [(2)](4) "Extract" means the following information from a [recent] RESTRICTED vital record:
 - (i) full names;
 - (ii) BIRTHPLACES, [occupations] OF PARENTS; AND
 - (iii) [places of residence;
 - (iv)] date and place of birth[, marriage, divorce] or death
 - (v) family relationships as stated in the record; and
 - (vi) name and relationship of the informant].
- (5) "FILE" MEANS TO PRESENT FOR REGISTRATION AT THE DEPARTMENT ANY CERTIFICATE OF BIRTH, DEATH, ADOPTION, MARRIAGE, DIVORCE, OR ANNULMENT.
