- (5) 1 member of the Senate from Harford County or a designee of the member;
- (6) The Harford County. Executive or a designee of the County Executive; and
- (7) The President of the Cecil County Board of Commissioners or a designee of the President.
- (b) Each appointed member shall be knowledgeable in conservation, recreation, and environmental concerns.
- (c) Before taking office, each appointee to the Board shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution.
 - (d) (1) The term of an appointed member is 4 years.
- (2) The terms of the appointed members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Board on July 1, 1990.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (e) The Governor may remove a member for incompetence or misconduct.] [8-1504.
- (a) From among its members, the Susquehanna River Watershed Advisory Board shall select a chairman.
 - (b) The manner of election of officers shall be as the Board determines.
- (c) The chairman may not serve more than one 2-year term.] [8-1505.
 - (a) A majority of the authorized membership of the Board is a quorum.
- (b) (1) The Board shall meet at least 4 times a year, at the times and places determined by the chairman.
- (2) The chairman may schedule a meeting of the Board only at a public facility in Harford or Cecil County.
- (3) The chairman shall give reasonable advance notice of a regular meeting of the Board by publication in the Maryland Register.
 - (c) A member of the Board:
 - (1) May not receive compensation; but
- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
