- (9) space for public buildings;
- (10) traffic control;
- (11) urban renewal; and
- (12) any other community need or project that the Commission believes may improve:
- (i) the facilities and development of Annapolis and adjacent areas; and
 - (ii) the facilities and development of any unit of the State government.
 - (d) (1) A study or recommendation of the Commission is advisory only.
- (2) The Commission may not require or compel the adoption or implementation of any recommendation.]

In addition to any powers set forth elsewhere, the Commission:

- (1) may accept money from a private or public agency for use in carrying out the powers and duties of the Commission; and
- (2) for that purpose, may give the money to a private or public agency or otherwise spend the money.]

- (1) the Governor;

- (a) The Council consists of 27 members appointed by the Governor.
- (b) Of the 27 Council members:
 - (1) 1 shall be a member of the State Senate;

 - (3) 3 shall represent the business community;
 - (4) 1 shall represent organized labor;
