because of the nature of the employee's [duties] DUTIES, is required to work on any part of [a holiday listed in Article 1, § 27 of the Code] AN EMPLOYEE HOLIDAY shall receive compensatory time for that work.

- (2) AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS INCLUDED IN THE EXECUTIVE PAY PLAN AT A PAY GRADE OF (ES) 6 OR ABOVE MAY RECEIVE COMPENSATORY TIME FOR WORK ON AN EMPLOYEE HOLIDAY ONLY IF THE EMPLOYEE WORKS 5 OR MORE HOURS ON THE HOLIDAY. THE EMPLOYEE SHALL RECEIVE 1 DAY OF COMPENSATORY TIME FOR EACH EMPLOYEE HOLIDAY ON WHICH THE EMPLOYEE WORKS 5 HOURS OR MORE.
- (B) AN EMPLOYEE MUST USE ANY COMPENSATORY TIME ACCRUED UNDER THIS SECTION WITHIN 1 YEAR AFTER HAVING ACCRUED THAT TIME.

- (a) (1) This section applies only to employees who are included in the Executive Pay Plan at a pay grade of (ES) 6 or above.
- (2) This section does not apply to compensatory time earned on or before June 30, 1989.
- (b) On or after July 1, 1989, an employee subject to this section may not accrue any compensatory time other than for work on a holiday and only if the employee works 5 or more hours on the holiday.
- (c) An employee subject to this section accrues 1 workday of compensatory time for each holiday on which the employee works 5 hours or more.
- (d) An employee must use any compensatory time accrued under this section within 1 year after having accrued that time.]

Subtitle 3. Annual Leave.

7-301.

This subtitle applies to all classified service and unclassified service employees in the State Personnel Management System.]

[7-302.] 9-301.

- (a) Each employee [subject to this subtitle] IN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, EXCEPT A TEMPORARY EMPLOYEE, is entitled to annual leave with pay as provided in this subtitle.
 - (b) Annual leave may be used for any purpose.
