- (vi) Provide or assure alcohol and drug abuse treatment for substance abusing pregnant women <u>AND ALL OTHER ENROLLEES OF MANAGED CARE</u> ORGANIZATIONS WHO REQUIRE THESE SERVICES;
- (vii) Educate Program recipients ENROLLEES on health care prevention and good health habits;
- (viii) Assure necessary provider capacity in all geographic areas under contract;
- (IX) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (9) OF THIS SUBSECTION, PROVIDE DIAGNOSTIC, EMERGENCY, PREVENTIVE, AND RESTORATIVE DENTAL SERVICES FOR CHILDREN AND FOR ADULTS;
- (ix) (X) (IX) Be accountable AND HOLD ITS SUBCONTRACTORS ACCOUNTABLE for standards established by the Department and, upon failure to meet those standards, be subject to a penalty up to and including revocation of its Medicaid managed care contract ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING PENALTIES:
 - 1. FINES;
 - 2. SUSPENSION OF FURTHER ENROLLMENTS;
 - 3. WITHHOLDING OF ALL OR PART OF THE CAPITATION
- PAYMENT;
- 4. TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT;
- 5. <u>DISQUALIFICATION FROM FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN</u>

THE PROGRAM; AND

6. ANY OTHER PENALTIES THAT MAY BE IMPOSED BY THE

DEPARTMENT; and

- (x) (XI) Subject to applicable federal and State law, include incentives for Program recipients ENROLLEES to comply with provisions of the managed care [plan] ORGANIZATION[, and disincentives for failing to comply with provisions of the managed care plan];
- (XII) PROVIDE OR ARRANGE TO PROVIDE THOSE PRIMARY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES TRADITIONALLY DELIVERED BY PRIMARY CARE PROVIDERS;

(XIII) PROVIDE EXCEPTIONAL NEEDS CARE COORDINATORS TO ASSIST INDIVIDUALS IN SPECIAL NEEDS POPULATIONS, AS DEFINED BY THE DEPARTMENT THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT ASSURE THAT MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS EMPLOY APPROPRIATE PERSONNEL TO:

- (1) ASSURE THAT INDIVIDUALS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS OBTAIN
 NEEDED SERVICES; AND
 - (2) COORDINATE THOSE SERVICES;
