**CHAPTER 389**

**(Senate Bill 353)**

AN ACT concerning

**University of Maryland Medical System Corporation – Board of Directors**

FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Board of Directors of the University of Maryland Medical System Corporation by providing for a range in the number of voting members on the Board.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Education

Section 13-1B-04(b)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1992 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Education**

13-1B-04.

(b) The Board of Directors consists of 6 nonvoting members and NOT LESS THAN 22 AND NOT MORE THAN ~~32~~ 27 voting members appointed by the Governor.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1996.
