SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health Occupations

[12–305.

- (a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board may make a reciprocal agreement with any other state to waive any examination requirement of this title for an individual who is licensed to practice pharmacy in that state.
- (b) An agreement made under this section may allow the Board to grant a waiver only if the individual:
 - (1) Is of good moral character;
 - (2) Pays the application fee set by the Board; and
