SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

~~(a) In this section, "license" has the meaning stated in § 10-226(a)(2) of this subtitle.~~

~~(b) This section:~~

~~(1) applies only to a fee for an initial license issued for a 2-year term under the provisions of the Business Occupations and Professions Article OR THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 8, TITLE 9A, OR TITLE 12 OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE;~~

~~(2) does not apply to a fee for the renewal of a license; and~~

~~(3) may not affect any other law that requires a unit to prorate a fee on any basis for the issuance or renewal of a license.~~

~~(e) (1) For a license issued at any time during the first year of the term of the license, the issuing authority shall charge the full amount of the fee to the license applicant.~~

~~(2) For a license issued in the second year of the term of the license, the issuing authority shall charge the license applicant:~~

~~(i) one-half of the fee, if issued in the first 6 months of the second year; or~~

~~(ii) one-quarter of the fee, if issued in the last 6 months of the second year.~~
