- (2) A Class B (for hire) vehicle;
- (3) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a manufacturer's rated capacity of [3/4] ONE ton or less;
 - (4) A Class G (trailer) vehicle; or
 - (5) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.
- (g) (1) A special registration number as specified by the Administration and assigned under this section may consist of:
 - (i) Any combination of:
 - 1. Letters; and
 - 2. Numerals; and
- (ii) Any design approved by the Administration that adequately reflects the geographical, historical, natural resource, or environmental theme which the plate commemorates.
- (2) A special registration number or design assigned under this section shall be displayed on the registration plates for the vehicle.

- (a) The owner of a motor vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a lease not intended as security, or a director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity that owns the vehicle who is a member of an organization considered eligible by the Administration may apply to the Administration for the assignment of a special registration number if the vehicle is included in one of the following classes:
 - (1) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;
- (2) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a manufacturer's rated capacity of [3/4] ONE ton or less; or
 - (3) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.
- (c) The Administration may issue and continue a special registration number under this section if:
- (1) The owner of the motor vehicle submits, with the original application, proof satisfactory to the Administration that the owner of the vehicle is a member of a nonprofit organization and complies with the regulations adopted by the Administration under subsection (d) of this section; and
- (2) At least 25 owners of vehicles in a class apply to the Administration for the assignment of special registration numbers, and at least 25 special registration numbers are issued initially.
