- (4) In the 47th alcoholic beverages district in Baltimore City, the hours for off-sales under a Class B beer, wine and liquor license for use in a restaurant are as provided for in § 6-201(d) of this article.
- (c) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class C beer, wine and liquor license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. the day following.
- (2) In Annapolis, the hours shall be as fixed by the Mayor, Counselor and Aldermen of Annapolis.
- (3) In Kent County the hours of sale are as provided under § 11-515 of this article.
- (4) In Montgomery County, the hours of sale are as provided in § 11-516 of this article.
- (d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class D beer, wine and liquor license may be exercised are from 6 a.m. to 12 midnight.
- (2) In EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, IN Baltimore City the hours are from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m.
- (3) In Caroline County the hours are from 6 a.m. Monday through Saturday until 1 a.m. the following day (including Sunday).
  - (4) In Baltimore County the hours are from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m.
- (5) In Queen Anne's County the hours on Monday through Saturday are from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.
- (6) In Wicomico County the hours are from 10 a.m. to 2 a.m., Monday through Saturday. Where sales are permitted until 2 a.m., alcoholic beverages may not be consumed after 2:30 a.m., at which time all tables and bar areas shall be cleared of all alcoholic beverages.
- (E) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY ON THE INNER PARAMETER OF A RECTANGLE BOUNDED BY 31ST STREET ON THE SOUTH, GREENMOUNT AVENUE ON THE EAST, 32ND STREET ON THE NORTH, AND BARCLAY STREET ON THE WEST.
- (2) BY REGULATION, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY RESTRICT THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR.
