(ii) two shall be appointed by the District Council of Prince George's County:

(iii) two shall be appointed by the Prince George's County House of Delegates Delegation; and

(iv) two shall be appointed by the Prince George's County Senate Select Committee.

(c) On or before December 1, 1996, the Commission shall complete its study and report its findings and recommendations to the Prince George's County Senate and House Delegations.

SECTION 4. <u>6.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1996.
