(2) SHALL MAINTAIN RESIDENCY IN HOWARD COUNTY THROUGHOUT THE TERM OF APPOINTMENT.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

11–170.

- (a) "Travel trailer" means a vehicle that:
 - (1) Is mounted on wheels;
- (2) Is of such a size and weight as not to require any special highway movement permit when towed by a motor vehicle;
- (3) <u>Is designed and constructed primarily to provide temporary living</u> quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use; and
 - (4) Is no longer than 40 feet.
