- [(a-1) (1) Each register shall distribute annually to the Comptroller the fees collected for providing a probate information booklet and materials under § 2-206(p) of this subtitle.
- (2) The Comptroller shall deposit the fees received under this subsection to the General Fund of the State.
- (b) The account shall include a report of expenses listing the employees of the office. It shall state the rate of compensation allowed to each employee, and the duties performed by him. Each employee shall append a verified certificate that the duties have been performed by him and that he has received the full sum charged to him and that he has not paid, deposited, assigned, or contracted to pay, deposit, or assign a part of the compensation to a person, nor directly or indirectly, paid or given or contracted to pay or give a reward or compensation for his office or employment.]
- [(c)] (B) The excess of fees and receipts over expenses shall be delivered by the register to the Comptroller with each report.
- (C) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DEPOSIT THE FEES RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION IN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1996.
