Board of County Commissioners to authorize a certain nonprofit organization to use the facilities of the Board of County Commissioners or the Charles County Community College; authorizing the Board of County Commissioners to provide certain funds to a nonprofit organization to operate a Commission; and generally relating to the authority of the Board of County Commissioners to establish an Economic Development Commission.

Section 27-18

Article 9 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1994 Edition and November 1995 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 9 - Charles County

27-18.

- A. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION B OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ESTABLISH AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION IN THE COUNTY AND PROVIDE FUNDS SUFFICIENT FOR THE PROPER OPERATION OF AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION.
- (2) AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION ESTABLISHED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE OPERATED BY A BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
- B. (1) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ANY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION TO OPERATE THE FUNCTIONS OF AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION.
- (2) UNDER THE TERMS OR CONDITIONS OF AN AGREEMENT ENTERED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY AUTHORIZE A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO USE THE BUILDINGS OR PREMISES OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OR THE CHARLES COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
- (3) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY PROVIDE FUNDS TO A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION IN AN AMOUNT THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CONSIDER NECESSARY TO OPERATE AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
