SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

13-303.

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED:
- (2) "INSTITUTION" MEANS ANY CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM.
- (3) "MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND NATIONAL GUARD" MEANS ANY RESIDENT OF THE STATE WHO:
- (I) IS-REGULARLY ENLISTED-IN THE MARYLAND NATIONAL GUARD; OR
- (II) HOLDS A COMMISSION IN THE MARYLAND NATIONAL GUARD
 AS:
 - 1. AN OFFICER IN THE GRADE OF CAPTAIN OR BELOW; OR
 - 2. A WARRANT OFFICER.
- (4) "TUITION" MEANS THE BASIC INSTRUCTIONAL CHARGE FOR COURSES AND DOES NOT PERTAIN TO SELF-SUPPORTING PROGRAMS OR INCLUDE FEES, SUCH AS THOSE FOR REGISTRATION, APPLICATION, OR LABORATORY WORK
- (5) "TUITION WAIVER" MEANS THE WAIVER OF ONE-HALF OF THE TUITION CHARGED FOR A CREDIT OR NONCREDIT COURSE.
- (B) AN INSTITUTION SHALL WAIVE ONE HALF OF THE TUITION OF ANY SCHEDULED CREDIT OR NONCREDIT COURSE FOR A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND NATIONAL GUARD IF:
 - (1) THE MEMBER IS ENROLLED AT THE INSTITUTION;
- (2) THE MEMBER IS CERTIFIED AS ELIGIBLE BY THE MARYLAND ADJUTANT GENERAL, AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION;
- (3) THE MEMBER IS NOT RECEIVING A TUITION WAIVER FOR MORE THAN FIVE COURSES PER TERM: AND
