**CHAPTER 551**

**(House Bill 1396)**

AN ACT concerning

**Boxers and Kick Boxers – Blood Tests**

FOR the purpose of requiring boxers and kick boxers to submit ~~to a~~ certain evidence of certain results of blood test tests for human immunodeficiency virus and Hepatitis B at certain times; ~~prohibiting a boxer or kick boxer who has tested positive for human immunodeficiency virus or Hepatitis B to enter a ring~~ providing that a boxer or kick boxer may enter the ring only under certain circumstances; requiring that certain tests for the presence of HIV be conducted in accordance with certain provisions of law; requiring the Commission to keep certain information confidential; establishing certain criminal penalties for certain violations; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to requiring boxers and kick boxers to submit certain results of certain blood tests ~~for boxers and kick boxers.~~
