- (ii) a sanctuary for wildlife.
- (c) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the governing body of a county or municipal corporation may provide, by law, for:
- (1) the amount and duration of the property tax credit under this section; and
- (2) any other provision necessary to carry out the property tax credit under this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October-1 June 1, 1996, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 1997 1996.

AN ACT concerning

Registration of Retail Service Station Dealers - Extension of Conversion Moratorium
