- (E) "CRIME OF VIOLENCE" MEANS:
 - (1) ABDUCTION;
 - (2) ARSON IN THE FIRST DEGREE;
 - (3) BURGLARY IN THE FIRST, SECOND, OR THIRD DEGREE;
 - (4) CARJACKING AND ARMED CARJACKING;
 - (5) ESCAPE;
 - (6) KIDNAPPING;
 - (7) VOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER;
 - (8) MAIMING;
 - (9) MAYHEM;
 - (10) MURDER IN THE FIRST OR SECOND DEGREE;
 - (11) RAPE IN THE FIRST OR SECOND DEGREE;
 - (12) ROBBERY:
 - (13) ROBBERY WITH A DANGEROUS OR DEADLY WEAPON;
 - (14) SEXUAL OFFENSE IN THE FIRST, SECOND, OR THIRD DEGREE;
 - (15) AN ATTEMPT TO COMMIT ANY OF THE AFORESAID OFFENSES; OR
- (16) ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO COMMIT ANY OF THE AFORESAID OFFENSES OR ANY OFFENSE PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR MORE THAN 1 YEAR.
 - (F) "DEALER" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO IS ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF:
- (1) SELLING, RENTING, OR TRANSFERRING FIREARMS AT WHOLESALE OR RETAIL; OR
 - (2) REPAIRING FIREARMS.
- (G) "DESIGNATED LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY APPROVED AND DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY TO PROCESS APPLICATIONS TO PURCHASE REGULATED FIREARMS FOR SECONDARY SALES.
 - (H) "ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO:
 - (1) IS LICENSED AS A MARYLAND REGULATED FIREARMS DEALER;
 - (2) IS LICENSED AS A FEDERAL FIREARMS DEALER:
