- (C) (1) THE BOARD SHALL WAIVE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION AS A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR-DRUG AND ALCOHOL ALCOHOL AND DRUG THERAPIST UNDER § 17.302.3 OF THIS TITLE FOR ANY PERSON WHO:
- (I) HAS FILED A LETTER OF INTENT WITH THE BOARD BY JULY 1, 1997;
- (II) HOLDS A MASTER'S OR DOCTORAL DEGREE IN A HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COUNSELING FIELD OR HAS COMPLETED A PROGRAM THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES TO BE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT IN SUBJECT MATTER AND EXTENT OF TRAINING AS A MASTER'S OR DOCTORAL DEGREE IN A HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COUNSELING FIELD; AND
- (III) AS OF JULY 1, 1996, IS CERTIFIED AS A CERTIFIED CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY COUNSELOR OR CERTIFIED CLINICAL SUPERVISOR BY THE MARYLAND ADDICTION COUNSELOR CERTIFICATION BOARD.
- (IV) HAS COMPLETED NOT LESS THAN 3 YEARS WITH A MINIMUM OF 3,000 HOURS OF SUPERVISED EXPERIENCE IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE COUNSELING APPROVED BY THE BOARD, 2 YEARS OF WHICH SHALL HAVE BEEN COMPLETED AFTER THE AWARD OF THE MASTER'S OR DOCTORAL DEGREE; AND
- (V) HAS, BY JULY 1, 2001, SUCCESSFULLY PASSED AN EXAMINATION APPROVED BY THE BOARD.
- (2) THE BOARD SHALL WAIVE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION AS A CERTIFIED <u>ASSOCIATE</u> COUNSELOR—DRUG—AND ALCOHOL ALCOHOL AND DRUG THERAPIST FOR ANY PERSON WHO HAS FILED A LETTER OF INTENT WITH THE BOARD BY JULY 1, 1997 IF:
- (I) THE PERSON HOLDS A BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN A HEALTH OR HUMAN SERVICES COUNSELING FIELD OR HAS COMPLETED A PROGRAM THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES TO BE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT IN SUBJECT MATTER AND EXTENT OF TRAINING TO A BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN A HEALTH OR HUMAN SERVICES COUNSELING FIELD; OR
- (II) THE PERSON, AS OF JULY 1, 1996, IS CERTIFIED AS A CERTIFIED CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY COUNSELOR OR CERTIFIED CLINICAL SUPERVISOR BY THE MARYLAND ADDICTION COUNSELOR CERTIFICATION BOARD OR IS EMPLOYED BY THE STATE IN THE CAPACITY OF A PROGRAM SPECIALIST I, II, OR III, OR ITS EQUIVALENT, IF THE PERSON IS EMPLOYED BY THE STATE, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE, OR AN ENTITY THAT PROVIDES ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELING SERVICES UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE; AND
- (III) THE PERSON HAS COMPLETED NOT LESS THAN 3 YEARS WITH A MINIMUM OF 3,000 HOURS OF SUPERVISED EXPERIENCE IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE COUNSELING APPROVED BY THE BOARD, 2 YEARS OF WHICH SHALL HAVE BEEN COMPLETED AFTER THE AWARD OF THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE.
 - (3) THE BOARD SHALL WAIVE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR
