~~(a) (1) The Board consists of [seven] NINE members appointed by the Governor with the advice of the Secretary.~~

~~(2) Of the [seven] NINE Board members:~~

~~(i) Five shall be certified as professional counselors, including:~~

~~1. One who is primarily engaged in professional counselor education;~~

~~2. One who is employed in the private sector;~~

~~3. One who is employed in the public sector; and~~

~~4. Two professional counselors at large;~~

~~(ii) One shall be a certified professional counselor marriage and family therapist; [and]~~

~~(iii) ONE SHALL BE A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR DRUG AND ALCOHOL ALCOHOL AND DRUG THERAPIST; AND~~

~~(iv) [One] TWO shall be [a] consumer [member] MEMBERS.~~

~~(3) The composition of the Board as to the race and sex of its members shall reflect the composition of the population of the State.~~

~~(4) The Governor shall appoint the professional counselors from a list submitted to the Governor by the Secretary. Any association representing professional counselors may submit recommendations for Board members to the Secretary.~~
