TO QUALIFY AS A CERTIFIED ASSOCIATE COUNSELOR-ALCOHOL AND DRUG AN APPLICANT SHALL:

- (1) HOLD A BACHELOR'S DEGREE FROM AN ACCREDITED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD IN A HEALTH OR HUMAN SERVICES COUNSELING FIELD OR HAVE COMPLETED A PROGRAM OF STUDIES JUDGED BY THE BOARD TO BE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT IN SUBJECT MATTER AND EXTENT OF TRAINING TO SUCH A PROGRAM OF STUDIES;
- (2) HAVE COMPLETED NOT LESS THAN 3 YEARS, WITH A MINIMUM OF 2,000 HOURS OF SUPERVISED EXPERIENCE IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELING APPROVED BY THE BOARD, 2 YEARS OF WHICH SHALL HAVE BEEN COMPLETED AFTER THE AWARD OF THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE;
- (3) HAVE A MINIMUM OF 20 CREDIT HOURS IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELOR TRAINING AS DEFINED IN § 17-302.3(D)(4) OF THIS TITLE; AND
- (4) PRACTICE ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELING UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR-ALCOHOL AND DRUG OR ANOTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDER APPROVED BY THE BOARD.

TO QUALIFY AS A CERTIFIED SUPERVISED COUNSELOR-ALCOHOL AND DRUG AN APPLICANT SHALL:

- (I) HOLD AN ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE IN A HEALTH OR HUMAN SERVICES COUNSELING FIELD OR HAVE COMPLETED A PROGRAM OF STUDIES JUDGED BY THE BOARD TO BE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT IN SUBJECT MATTER TO SUCH A PROGRAM OF STUDIES;
- (2) HAVE COMPLETED NOT LESS THAN 2 YEARS, WITH A MINIMUM OF 2,000 HOURS OF SUPERVISED EXPERIENCE IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELING APPROVED BY THE BOARD, 1 YEAR OF WHICH SHALL HAVE BEEN COMPLETED AFTER THE AWARD OF THE ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE;
- (3) HAVE A MINIMUM OF 15 CREDIT HOURS IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELING TRAINING AS DEFINED IN § 17–302.3(D)(4) OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (4) PRACTICE ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELING UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR-ALCOHOL AND DRUG OR ANOTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDER APPROVED BY THE BOARD AND PROVIDE ALCOHOL
