

(IV) THE EXISTING AND DESIRED LEVELS OF STAFF TURNOVER;
(V) THE EXISTING AND DESIRED STAFF QUALIFICATIONS; AND
(VI) THE EXISTING AND DESIRED ABILITY OF PROVIDERS TO OPERATE ON A SOLVENT BASIS IN THE DELIVERY OF EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT SERVICES THAT ARE IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST;

(2) THE COMPARABILITY OF DIRECT CARE AND MANAGERIAL STAFF SALARIES AND WAGES, INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, IN PROVIDER ORGANIZATIONS RELATIVE TO SIMILAR POSITIONS IN STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND IN SIMILAR HUMAN SERVICE FIELDS;

(3) THE EXTENT AND AMOUNT OF UNCOMPENSATED CARE DELIVERED BY PROVIDERS; AND

(4) THE ADEQUACY, EFFICIENCY, AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THE METHODS OF PAYMENTS TO PROVIDERS, INCLUDING THE REIMBURSEMENT RATE STRUCTURES EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY ADMINISTRATION, AND THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION.

IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES PROVIDED ELSEWHERE IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE COMMISSION MAY:

(1) ~~ADOPT~~ RECOMMEND THE ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) CREATE COMMITTEES FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS;

(3) APPOINT ADVISORY COMMITTEES THAT MAY INCLUDE INDIVIDUALS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF INTERESTED PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS;

(4) PUBLISH AND DISTRIBUTE INFORMATION THAT RELATES TO THE FINANCIAL ASPECTS OF COMMUNITY-BASED DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY OR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES; AND

(5) SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, EXERCISE ANY OTHER POWER THAT IS REASONABLY NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(A) THE POWER OF THE SECRETARY OVER PLANS, PROPOSALS, AND PROJECTS OF UNITS IN THE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT INCLUDE THE POWER TO DISAPPROVE OR MODIFY A DECISION OR DETERMINATION THAT THE COMMISSION MAKES UNDER AUTHORITY SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED TO THE COMMISSION BY LAW.
