- (C) THE MEMBERS APPOINTED TO THE AUTHORITY SHALL REPRESENT THE GENDER, RACIAL, AND GEOGRAPHIC MAKEUP OF THE STATE.
- (D) NO MEMBER OF THE AUTHORITY MAY ALSO BE A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF GOVERNING OR OVERSIGHT BODY OF A ORGANIZATION QUALIFYING FOR STATE FUNDS AS A RECOGNIZED OR CERTIFIED HERITAGE AREA.
- (B) (E) A CABINET MEMBER OF THE AUTHORITY MAY DESIGNATE A REPRESENTATIVE TO ACT IN THE ABSENCE OF THE CABINET MEMBER, IF THE REPRESENTATIVE IS NOT BELOW THE LEVEL OF ASSISTANT SECRETARY OR EQUIVALENT RANK.
- (C) (E) (I) EXCEPT FOR STATE OFFICIALS, THE TERM OF A MEMBER OF THE AUTHORITY IS 4 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS ON OCTOBER 1, 1996.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND OUALIFIES.
- (5) AT THE END OF THE TERM OF A MEMBER OR ON THE RESIGNATION OR REMOVAL OF A MEMBER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A MEMBER TO THE AUTHORITY WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
- (D) (F) (G) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER THAT A GOVERNOR APPOINTED FOR INCOMPETENCE, MISCONDUCT, OR FAILURE TO PERFORM THE DUTIES OF THE POSITION.

13-1107. 13-1105.

- (A) EIGHT NINE VOTING MEMBERS OF THE AUTHORITY ARE A QUORUM.
- (B) AN ACTION OF THE AUTHORITY MUST RECEIVE THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST SIX MEMBERS A MAJORITY OF THE VOTING MEMBERS OF THE AUTHORITY.
- (C) THE AUTHORITY SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.
 - (D) A MEMBER OF THE AUTHORITY:
 - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
