(V) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER, IF THE LICENSEE IS A FIRM.

WHILE A LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO:

- (1) CONDUCT A BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES SECURITY GUARD SERVICES FOR COMPENSATION OR FOR HIRE;
- (2) MAINTAIN AN OFFICE FOR THE CONDUCT OF BUSINESS AT EACH LOCATION STATED IN THE SECURITY GUARD AGENCY LICENSE CERTIFICATE:
- (3) EMPLOY INDIVIDUALS AS SECURITY GUARDS TO PROVIDES SECURITY GUARD SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC ON BEHALF OF THE LICENSEE; AND
- (4) REPRESENT THE LICENSEE TO THE PUBLIC AS A LICENSED SECURITY GUARD AGENCY.

- (A) UNLESS A LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 1-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE FIRST APRIL 30 AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LICENSE.
- (B) AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE SECRETARY SHALL MAIL TO THE LICENSEE, AT THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE:
 - (1) A RENEWAL APPLICATION FORM; AND
 - (2) A NOTICE THAT STATES:
 - (I) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;
- (II) THAT THE SECRETARY MUST RECEIVE THE RENEWAL APPLICATION AND THE ANNUAL STATEMENTS REQUIRED UNDER § 19–309 OF THIS SUBTITLE, ON OR BEFORE APRIL 15, FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES;
 - (III) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE;
- (IV) THAT, IF THE ANNUAL STATEMENTS ARE NOT RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE APRIL 15, A FEE OF \$10 PER DAY SHALL BE CHARGED AGAINST THE LICENSEE UNTIL THE STATEMENTS ARE RECEIVED; AND
- (V) THAT THE SUBMISSION OF A FALSE STATEMENT IN THE RENEWAL APPLICATION OR IN THE ANNUAL STATEMENTS IS CAUSE FOR REVOCATION OF THE LICENSE.
- (C) A LICENSEE PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW THE LICENSE FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR TERM. IF THE LICENSEE:
 - (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;
 - (2) PAYS TO THE SECRETARY:
