  - 1. IDENTIFY THE INDIVIDUAL; OR
  - 2. SPECIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL.

- (A) AT ANY TIME THAT A CERTIFIED SECURITY GUARD PROVIDES A SECURITY GUARD SERVICE, THE SECURITY GUARD SHALL CARRY THE CERTIFICATION CARD ISSUED UNDER § 19–405 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (B) ON REQUEST OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, A CERTIFIED SECURITY GUARD SHALL SHOW THE SECURITY GUARD'S CERTIFICATION CARD.

WHENEVER A SECURITY GUARD IS IN UNIFORM, THE SECURITY GUARD SHALL WEAR A BADGE THAT IS:

- (1) OF A DESIGN APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY; AND
- (2) ISSUED BY THE LICENSED SECURITY GUARD AGENCY THAT EMPLOYS THE SECURITY GUARD.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 19–410 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY MAY DENY CERTIFICATION AS A SECURITY GUARD TO ANY APPLICANT, REPRIMAND ANY INDIVIDUAL CERTIFIED AS A SECURITY GUARD, OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE CERTIFICATION OF AN INDIVIDUAL:

- (1) FOR ANY APPLICABLE GROUND UNDER § 19-313 OF THIS TITLE;
- (2) IF THE APPLICANT OR INDIVIDUAL FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS OR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN CERTIFICATION AS A SECURITY GUARD FOR THE APPLICANT OR INDIVIDUAL OR FOR ANOTHER; OR
- (3) IF THE APPLICANT OR INDIVIDUAL FAILS TO MAINTAIN THE STANDARDS SET BY THE SECRETARY FOR CERTIFICATION AS A SECURITY GUARD. 19–409.
- (A) SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY SHALL COMMENCE PROCEEDINGS UNDER § 19–408 OF THIS SUBTITLE ON THE SECRETARY'S OWN COMPLAINT OR ON A COMPLAINT MADE TO THE SECRETARY BY ANY PERSON.
  - (B) (1) A COMPLAINT SHALL:
    - (I) BE IN WRITING;
    - (II) BE SIGNED BY THE COMPLAINANT; AND
- (III) STATE SPECIFICALLY THE FACTS ON WHICH THE COMPLAINT IS BASED.
