CHAPTER 603

(House Bill 80)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Individuals with Disabilities - Parking

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from stopping, standing, or parking on a loading zone designed for the use of individuals with disabilities; requiring parking lots constructed or altered after a certain date to conform to requirements of the Maryland Accessibility Code; repealing certain nonconforming provisions relating to minimum parking spaces, size, and sign requirements; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to parking for individuals with disabilities.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

21-1003.

- (ee) A person may not stop, stand, or park a vehicle in front of OR ON a passenger loading zone designed or marked for the use of individuals with disabilities.

 21-1006.
- (a) [In this section, "parking lot" means any parking lot reserved for the use of persons entering a retail store or shopping center that has more than 20,000 square feet of usable floor area, except a parking lot built in compliance with the Maryland Building Code for the handicapped.
- (b) Except as otherwise mandated by federal law, each parking lot shall designate parking spaces for the use of individuals with disabilities as follows:

Total Parking	Required Minimum Number of Accessible Spaces for
Spaces in Lot	Individuals with Disabilities
Less than 9	0
10 - 25	1
26 – 100	2
101 - 300	4
301 - 500	6
501 – 800	8
801 - 1,000	10
