

(b) The Commissioner is empowered at any time to require any nonprofit health service plan in this State to demonstrate that its filings, including the terms and provisions of its contracts and its table of rates and its method for setting rates, are in compliance with subsection (a) hereof, notwithstanding that the filings then in effect had previously been approved by the Commissioner.

(c) If at any time subsequent to the applicable review period provided for in subsection (a) of this section, the Commissioner finds that a filing does not meet the requirements of this section, the Commissioner shall, after a hearing held upon not less than 10 days' written notice to the filer, specifying the matters to be considered at the hearing, issue an order to the filer specifying in what respects the Commissioner finds that the filing fails to meet the requirements of this section, and stating when, within a reasonable period thereafter, the filing shall be no longer effective. The order shall not affect any contract or policy made or issued prior to the expiration of the period set forth in the order. The order shall not directly affect any existing contract or policy between a nonprofit health service plan and a participant, established pursuant to a collective bargaining procedure.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.

CHAPTER 646

(House Bill 1084)

AN ACT concerning

Community Services Trust Fund

FOR the purpose of establishing a Community Services Trust Fund for the purpose of holding certain moneys that result from the long-term lease or sale of property and equipment of a Developmental Disabilities Administration facility or Mental Hygiene Administration facility; specifying the accounts in the Trust Fund; specifying the transfer of certain moneys from the accounts in the Trust Fund under certain circumstances; specifying the method of expenditures from the Trust Fund; specifying that any unspent funds in the Trust Fund may not be transferred or revert to the General Fund of the State; requiring the Governor to include in the annual Budget Bill a certain appropriation from specified special funds for a certain purpose; repealing a certain termination date related to certain special funds; repealing a certain provision concerning the proposed appropriation of certain moneys by the Governor in the annual Budget Bill under certain circumstances; specifying that this Act applies to certain sales or leases occurring after a certain date; providing for the effective date of this Act; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; ~~defining a certain term~~ certain terms; and generally relating to establishing a Community Services Trust Fund.
