

THE ORDER IS IN EFFECT A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$250, OR IF THE VIOLATION IS WILLFUL, A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.

(F) SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION FOR WILLFUL VIOLATION.

(1) AFTER NOTICE AND A HEARING, THE COMMISSIONER MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE LICENSE, CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY, OR CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION OF AN INSURER OR OTHER PERSON THAT VIOLATES A FINAL ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER.

(2) THE ORDER FOR SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION IS SUBJECT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-215 OF THIS ARTICLE.

TITLE 16. LIFE INSURANCE AND ANNUITIES.

SUBTITLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

16-101. SCOPE OF TITLE.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, THIS TITLE APPLIES TO CONTRACTS OF LIFE INSURANCE AND ANNUITIES, OTHER THAN REINSURANCE, GROUP LIFE INSURANCE, AND GROUP ANNUITIES.
