

(III) [Compensate] TO COMPENSATE staff employed by the [Commission under Article 41, § 18-301(d)(2) of the Code] TRUST TO ADMINISTER THE FUND.

(2) The Trust may not use any money in the Fund for any other purpose of the Trust.

(F) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 30 OF EACH YEAR, THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE BUDGET COMMITTEES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE FINANCIAL STATUS OF THE FUND DURING THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR.

Article 41 – Governor – Executive and Administrative Departments

[18-301.

(a) There is a Commission to Save the Lighthouses.

(b) (1) The Commission is composed of:

- (i) 2 members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker;
- (ii) 2 members of the Senate, appointed by the President; and
- (iii) 12 members appointed by the Governor, as follows:

- 1. The Secretary of Natural Resources, or the Secretary's designee;
- 2. 2 members representing the Maryland Association of Counties;
- 3. The Director of the Maryland Historical Trust;
- 4. 2 members representing the Maryland Congressional Delegation;
- 5. 1 member representing the Maryland Municipal League;
- 6. 2 members representing the Maryland Watermen's Association;
- 7. 1 member representing the Association of Maryland Pilots; and
- 8. 2 members of the general public.

(2) A member of the United States Coast Guard may serve as a technical advisor to the Commission.

(c) The members of the Commission shall select a Chairman from among themselves.

(d) (1) Staff shall be provided by the Maryland Historical Trust.
