- (2) THE FEES CHARGED SHALL BE SET SO AS TO PRODUCE FUNDS TO APPROXIMATE THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE LICENSURE CERTIFICATION PROGRAM, AND THE OTHER SERVICES PROVIDED TO MASSAGE THERAPISTS.
- (B) (1) THE BOARD SHALL PAY ALL FEES COLLECTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE TO THE COMPTROLLER OF THE STATE.
- (2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE ALL FEES TO THE STATE BOARD OF NURSING CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 8-206 OF THIS TITLE.
- (C) THE FEES SHALL BE USED EXCLUSIVELY TO COVER THE ACTUAL DOCUMENTED DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF FULFILLING THE STATUTORY AND REGULATORY DUTIES OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

- (A) (1) THERE IS A MASSAGE THERAPY ADVISORY COMMITTEE WITHIN THE BOARD.
- (2) THE COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF FIVE SIX MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE BOARD.
 - (3) OF THE FIVE SIX MEMBERS:
- (I) TWO SHALL BE REGISTERED NURSES LICENSED CHIROPRACTORS WHO ARE ALSO LICENSED CERTIFIED MASSAGE THERAPISTS; AND AND

- (2) DEVELOP AND RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD A CODE OF ETHICS FOR THE PRACTICE OF MASSAGE THERAPY FOR ADOPTION BY THE BOARD;
- (3) DEVELOP AND RECOMMEND <u>TO THE BOARD</u> THE REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE CERTIFICATION AS A MASSAGE THERAPIST;
- (4) EVALUATE THE CREDENTIALS OF APPLICANTS AND RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD LICENSURE CERTIFICATION OF APPLICANTS WHO FULFILL THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A LICENSE CERTIFICATE TO PRACTICE MASSAGE THERAPY;
