- (II) SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS. AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (10) THE COMMISSION SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF HEARING COMMENTS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC CONCERNING THE ISSUES THAT ARE BEING STUDIED BY THE COMMISSION.
- (E) (1) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION SHALL SERVE AS PRINCIPAL STAFF TO THE COMMISSION.
- (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE, THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES, THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING SHALL PROVIDE STAFF TO COMMISSION.
- (E) (1) THE PRIMARY STAFF FOR THE COMMISSION SHALL BE SELECTED JOINTLY BY THE GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE, AND THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS.
- (2) THE FOLLOWING STATE AGENCIES SHALL COOPERATE FULLY WITH THE COMMISSION:
- (I) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION;
 - (II) THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE;
 - (III) THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES;
 - (IV) THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS;
- (V) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES;
 - (VI) THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING;
 - (VII) THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE;
 - (VIII) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE; AND
 - (IX) THE STATE BOARD OF VICTIM SERVICES.
- (3) ALL COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENTS AND AGENCIES SHALL COOPERATE FULLY WITH THE COMMISSION.
- (F) (1) THE PURPOSE OF THE COMMISSION IS TO EVALUATE THE STATE'S SENTENCING AND CORRECTIONAL LAWS AND POLICIES AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE POLICY GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THIS SUBSECTION REGARDING THE FOLLOWING ISSUES:
