

This bill extends the sunset date for the Business Regulation Article related to the State Board of Barbers from July 1, 1996 to July 1, 2001 and requires an evaluation of the regulations that relate to the State Board of Barbers by July 1, 2000.

House Bill 464, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 14, 1996, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 349.

**Senate Bill No. 349**

AN ACT concerning

**State Board of Barbers – Sunset Extension**

FOR the purpose of extending the termination date for the provisions of law relating to barbers and the State Board of Barbers; providing that, by a certain date, the Department of Fiscal Services shall complete a certain evaluation of the State Board of Barbers and the regulations that relate to the State Board of Barbers; and generally relating to the State Board of Barbers.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
Article – Business Occupations and Professions  
Section 4-702  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1995 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

BY adding to  
Article – State Government  
Section 8-403(1)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1995 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

4-702.

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [1996] 2001.
